Sec. 551 et seq</p>	<p>Section 2. <u>Executive</u></p> <p>The Board shall exercise its executive power by the appointment of a district Superintendent, who shall enforce the statutes of the Commonwealth, the regulations of the State Board of Education, the policies of the Board, and all other applicable laws and regulations.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall be responsible for the preparation of administrative guidelines for the operation of the school district that are not inconsistent with state and federal statutes or regulations; are dictated by the policies of this Board; and are binding on district employees and students when issued but shall require Board approval prior to distribution.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall be delegated the authority to take necessary action in circumstances not provided for in Board policy, provided that such action be reported to the Board at the next meeting.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall implement a procedure to inform Board members and designated employees of their responsibility under the Ethics Law.</p> <p>Whenever responsibility is delegated to the Superintendent or other administrator, it is understood that such individual may designate a representative to act on his/her behalf.</p> <p>Section 3. <u>Review</u></p> <p>The Board may assume jurisdiction over controversies or disputes arising within this school district concerning any matter over which the Board has authority granted by statute or where the Board has retained jurisdiction in contract or policies.</p> <p>In furtherance of its adjudicatory function, the Board may hold hearings in accordance with law which shall offer the parties to a dispute, on notice duly given, a fair and impartial forum for the resolution of the matter.</p>
