<p>1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 4.13 SC 801, 803</p>	<p>The Board shall provide instructional and evaluative materials to implement and support the district's and the schools' educational goals and academic standards.</p>
<p>2. Definition</p>	<p>Resource materials shall include reference books, supplementary titles, multimedia materials, maps, library books, software and instructional material.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility SC 803</p>	<p>The Superintendent, after consultation with the Instructional Design Team, shall be responsible for the selection, recommendation, and maintenance of all resource materials. No adoption or change of materials shall be made without the Superintendent's recommendation, except by a two-thirds vote of the Board.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop and implement selection procedures for resource materials.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p>	<p>Selection procedures for resource materials shall be developed which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Instructional Design Team shall participate in the selection process. 2. Ensure that the Board's budgetary allotment for resource materials is spent efficiently and distributed equitably throughout the instructional program. 3. Ensure an inventory of resource materials that is well-balanced and well-rounded in coverage of subject, types of materials, and variety of content. 4. Evaluate the effectiveness of resource materials presently in use. 5. Direct staff to consult a variety of media sources before selections are made.
